



AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITY – Spanish

Overview

Spanish will be offered this spring and taught by veteran teacher and native Spanish speaker, Hortensia Benitez. The mission is to teach Spanish as a second language with native fluency. Students experience Spanish in a variety of ways while concentrating on key concepts. Classes center on student interests and abilities. It is the beginning of a fun journey of discovery, exploration, and adventure. New vocabulary will be taught each week and reviewed. Lessons include songs, games, storytelling, drama, and manipulatives as well as crafts and hands-on activities. There is a weekly newsletter for parents to accompany each lesson. The winter/spring offering of after school Spanish has a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 14 students.
