
WILD WEST WEEK: JULY 25TH - JULY 29TH FIELD TRIP: WILMINGTON WESTERN RAILROAD

- Wednesdays STUDENTS WILL NEED TO PACK A BAGGED LUNCH for onsite and off-site field trip days so we can do picnic style lunches.
- If you would like to pack a lunch any other day of the week, please feel free to do so.
- Camp Firefly does not offer a "forgotten lunch option."
- Campers are not permitted to use the vending machines in the school.
- Our Preschool campers will be in the same building for the first few weeks and then will be moved into our Preschool building.
- Each campers must fill out an emergency card and return it ASAP.
- T-shirts are being processed will be here for our first field trip.
- Due to the ever-changing COVID regulations, we may need to make adjustments to our field trips as some of the previously scheduled trips. Please be patient and flexible with our schedule!
- Fridays are WATER DAYS! We will have water activities outside as well as water ice at no additional cost!
- Campers should come in their bathing suits with a change of clothes, towel, and sunscreen. They will change after the activities and take their wet clothes home in a bag.
