

YOU WILL BE CHARGED if your child does not attend camp if one week notice was not provided. 2. Family Discounts—Receive 10% off weekly tuition for each additional members of the family.
3. Drop-off and Pick-up Times—Your child can be dropped off anytime after 7:00am. Please be sure to have your child at RLCA EEC Building no later that 9:00am. Summer Camp officially ends at 4:00pm. After care is everyday from 4:00pm to 6:00pm. Pickup after 6:00pm will result in a late fee of \$5 per 5 minutes late.
